

## Project Update: September 2023

The following grant has immensely helped to contribute to the following outcomes:

- Created and established a Shark and Ray Gulf of Guinea Network to implement an effective management approach for the West African region.
- Hosted the first workshop of the Gulf of Guinea Shark and Ray Network in Cameroon, which has been organised by AMMCO and the Manta Trust, and in line with the Street Whale event.
- Presented the shark and ray conservation and research activities and outcomes at the Street Whale event, which AMMCO hosts every year in June.
- Presentation of shark and ray conservation activities and findings that have been carried out by AMMCO in Cameroon at the West Africa Marine Science Symposium (WAMSS) in August.
- Participation in the Convention on Migratory Species (CMS) meeting in September to present the conservation and management strategy draft for sharks and rays in the Gulf of Guinea region.
