


Project Update: June 2010

The project effectively began on May 31st 2010 with training of project members on the necessary field methodologies to be used in the different phases of the project. Purchase of supplies needed in the field were also made and contact visits were done at Idenau, Bafia, Ekona and Buea town to inform the local communities about the project, to familiarise with the local communities, to hire local guides and to schedule visits for ecological diversity study of macro-fungi in these areas. The first phase of this project which included training of project members, contact visits with local communities and familiarising with the study area was successfully attained. Ecological diversity survey would begin on June 1st, 2010.
