

Project Update: February 2012

The biogas digester is now up and running again. Our current programme for waste management in the park is that organic waste is added at the end of each day to the digester and that inorganic waste is placed in the appropriate bin and taken away monthly to Tamba. It is now the tourist season in Senegal, and with the increase of rubbish (we are currently transporting approx. 400kg of rubbish out of the park each month) and increasingly hot days, waste food being thrown in the inorganic bins is making the monthly collection an unpleasant job. To improve the situation we have put up posters giving more information of how rubbish should be thrown away. We have also put up a poster next to the biogas digester to explain more about the technology of biogas.
