

Project Update: August 2012

From April: Medicinal Wildlife Quarter Hour continues at Abakwa Radio, Bamenda. One RSG-subsidized hunting permit granted.

June: The Training Seminar for tradi-practitioners on the sustainable use of medicinal wildlife held in Bamenda on 30th June 2012 with theme: *Preserving Medicinal Wildlife for a Healthier World*. It was officiated at by the Regional Delegate of Public Health (represented) with resource persons from the Regional Delegations of Forestry/Wildlife, Livestock/Animal Breeding and Institute of Agronomic Research. It had 24 participants and was press-covered by: LTM-TV CNTV, Abakwa radio, Foundation Radio and Cameroon Tribune and The Herald Tribune.
